

## **Itinerary - Beaumaris, Aberlleiniog Castle and Penmon**

Grid Reference: **SH 602 760 - SH 616 793 – SH 631 807**

Three linked sites with heritage, landscape and wildlife. Some travelling in between.

### **Beaumaris Castle ~ 3 hours**

A World Heritage Site with neighbouring car park. A range of tourist facilities in the town.

### **Aberlleiniog Castle Scheduled Ancient Monument and Nature Reserve ~ 2 hours**

Two free car parks:

- Llangloed village car park, with 200m walk to entrance of reserve.
- Lleiniog Beach car park, with 200m walk to entrance of reserve.
- Access point also from lane to the north (no parking).

Paths and boardwalks and access to the restored Norman motte and bailey castle. Paths through the extensive mixture of ancient semi-natural and newly planted woodland and damp meadow. Great for woodland birds and a lovely spot for a picnic!

### **Penmon Point (Black Point) ~ 2 hours**

- Pay car park.
- Historical priory, church and dovecote.
- Café and souvenir shop.
- Walks around Black Point headland.
- Fine views to the mountains and across Puffin Sound to Puffin Island.
- Black Point lighthouse.
- Lots of seabirds of all kinds—large seabird colony on Puffin Island.
